#### Introduction

The Small-scale Fisheries Management for Better Livelihood and Fisheries Resources project aims in the sustainable management of small-scale fisheries for improving the livelihood and well-being of fishers in Southeast Asia. In 2020, the project has conducted the activities in application and implementation of EAFM in the learning site of Ranong Province, Thailand. Ban Hat Sai Khao village is selected to be the Fisheries Management Unit (FMU) in application of the EAFM concept. The EAFM training course was organized to provide knowledge and strengthen capacity of the fisheries officers and key stakeholders to further develop EAFM plan, moreover, the baseline survey was carried out in the learning site to know the status and make better understanding the situation of the area and further development of EAFM plan for the pilot learning site of Ranong Province during the key stakeholder engagement workshop, the project activities are designed under three components of EAFM concept with discussion among key stakeholder of the pilot area. Then, the project has implemented the activities under the EAFM plan namely: promotion of fish processing activity, training on fisheries law and regulation, and establishment of Squid Bank. Therefore, SEAFDEC/TD plan to follow up the project activities at Ban Hat Sai Khao village to monitor the progress of activities under the EAFM plan of the learning site in 13-14 December 2023.

- 2. To identify the challenges and opportunity in implementing project activities

#### **Expected Outputs:**

- The progress of project activity implementation under EAFM plan such as fish processing and squid bank will be update and the challenges and opportunity will be identified as well as the technical advice and suggestion will be provided to the key stakeholders in learning site for sustainable fisheries resources management.
