




 Brunei Darussalam is located in the northwestern part of Borneo with an area of 5,765km² and 161 km long coastline fronting South China Sea.

Monitoring, Control & Surveillance (MCS)

- DOF currently working together with Brunei Navy and Marine Police to monitor the Offshore Fishing activities and/or to apprehend any illegal entrance by foreign fishing vessels into Brunei Waters;
- Marine Police monitor Brunei waters within Zone 2 to Zone 3, whereas Brunei Navy covers Zone 3 to Zone 4 areas;
- Maritime Control Tower (MPABD) monitoring and report all vessels activities in Brunei waters including unauthorized entry;
- Foreign fishing vessel request entry to designated port Require to comply MPABD SOP, MOH sanitization requirement and DOF permit.

- Trial to establish E ACDS in Brunei DOF working closely with SEAFDEC and stakeholders to practice Catch Documentation preparation such as:-
- ☐ Port Out & Port In Record;
- Movement Documentation;
- □ Catch Certification (for traceability and comply with importing countries requirements);
