





# Royal Ordinance on Fisheries B.E. 2558 (A.D. 2015)

 To develop hygiene standards relating to the catching, caretaking, and processing of aquatic animals, and the storage, transportation or transshipment of aquatic animals and animal products.

# Royal Ordinance on Fisheries B.E. 2558 (A.D. 2015)

"Section 92 Subject to section 96, no person shall import fish and fishery products unless permission is obtained from a competent official. Any person wishing to export or bring in transit aquatic animals and aquatic animal products shall first produce a catch certificate or any other document which proves that such aquatic animals and aquatic animal products are obtained from a legal fishing operation to the competent official for inspection.

# Section 92 (cont -)

The granting of permission pursuant to paragraph one shall be executed only when a catch certificate or any other document is presented proving that such aquatic animals and aquatic animal products are obtained from a lawful fishing operation.

The requesting and granting of permission pursuant to paragraph one shall be in accordance with the rules, procedures and conditions prescribed by the Director - General.

The provision under paragraph one shall not apply to the bringing of aquatic animals caught by a Thai fishing vessel in a lawful fishing operation into the Kingdom. Any such case shall not be regarded as importation.

Animal Epidemic Act B.E. 2558 (2015) DoF staff have been appointed by he Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives to be inspectors and veterinarians to execute the Animal Epidemic Act for aquatic animal disease prevention and control.

# Wildlife Conservation and Protection Act B.E. 2562 (2019)

- No person shall, within a Wild Animal Sanctuary, hunt Wild Animal, either presered or protected Wild Animal, or collect or endanger any nest, except for educational purposes or scientific research and written permission must be obtained from the Director-General with the approval of the committee.

### Import and Export Control





- Copy of Invoice
- Copy of Bill of Lading
- Copy of <u>Catch certificate</u> or a copy of <u>Custom clearance</u> or a copy of Custom declaration or Export certification or documents proving that fish and Fishery product are not derived from illegal, unreported and unregulated (IUU) fishing)
- Copyof Animal Health Certificate for Live fish



# **Procedure for Import Control**

• If not detected, FIO release goods. If any residue is detected, FIO informs Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for further actions.

 If not detected, FIO release goods. If any disease is detected, FIO destroy or disinfect by burning/landfill/boiling. If any residue is detected, FIO inform FDA for further actions





- Copy of Invoice
- Copy of <u>Catch certificate</u> or a copy of <u>Processing Statement</u> for EU and Japan
- Copyof Animal Health Certificate for Live fish
- Copy of **Health Certificate** for EU, China, Russia and Saudiarabia


