

## Flag State Responsibilities



Ensure all vessels are operating with permission, not engage in or support IUU fishing, in own waters or high seas



Maintain an updated Record of Fishing Vessels-MFVR

- Flag, unique registered name
- Avoid flagging vessel with a history of noncompliance



Prevent "flag hopping"



Ensure that Malaysia can exercise its responsibility before registers any fishing vessel

• Take all basic steps before register any fishing vessel






## Coastal State Responsibilities

• Exploring, Exploiting, Conserving and Managing the living marine resources under our jurisdiction



- Capture fisheries Development Plan
- Data collection & Stock Survey
- Marine Protected Area
- Fisheries Management Plan

## Port State Responsibilities

- Control of Port admission for foreign fishing vessel in order to prevent, deter and eliminate IUU fishing.
- Port access for reasons of *force majeure* or distress
- Require foreign fishing vessel to seek permission to enter port
- Do not granted access to the port for a vessel that has engaged in IUU fishing activity- clear evidence
- Share information with flag StateCooperate accordingly
